Terms of Reference Editorial Board

Mandate

The editorial board is established primarily to provide advice to the editor of *Rhetor* in the following areas:

- Make suggestions to match reviewers with experts in the field of the submissions
- Review submissions when necessary
- Address any matter pertaining to editorial policy that may arise (e.g. thematic issues or sections of issues; call for papers, etc.)

Board Members

Shall consist of a minimum of 4 members, in addition to the current editor of Rhetor:

- At least one member should be a past editor of *Rhetor*
- At least one member of the board should be a francophone
- At least 2 regular CSSR members whose backgrounds support the committee

Terms

- Terms shall end on a staggered basis and shall be 4-year terms starting 2014
- Editorial advisors will be nominated and voted upon at the annual AGM

Responsibilities

- To assist *Rhetor's* editor with editorial advice
- To offer expertise about submissions' content
- To recommend reviewers who are expert in the field of the submission.
